Fall Clean Up

Soon the leaves will begin to fall. As you clean up your lot there are a couple options for your leaves. Mulching them with a lawn mower is always an option. You can also rake them and bag them in a brown paper leaf bag and leave them by the road for our crew to pick up. They must be in brown paper lawn bags. Leaves can be burned as long as the water has not been turned off in the campground.

The end of season is a great time to clean up around your site. If you have items that won't fit in the dumpster <u>DO NOT</u> place them on the ground next to the dumpster. You must take those items home or find another way to dispose of them.

Your cooperation in this helps keep your campground the beautiful and enjoyable place we all love.

REMINDER - Electric News

Power will be left on now all winter for the campground. This means at the end of the camping season you will still have power at your camper. However, you will not receive an electric bill during the off-season, but you will see whatever usage you may have used over the winter months on your April bill.

As always, if you want to ensure there is no electric usage you need to unplug your main power from the electric pedestal.


2026 Season Rate Changes

LEASE

The 1stinstallment for the 2026 season is due by November 1st, 2025. Remember there is a \$15 late fee per day for all late payments. Payments must be processed through our office by November 1st, meaning any payments that are sent through the mail or bank authorization payments that are received after November 1st will be subject to late penalties.

Water is scheduled to be shut off to the campground on October 15th



A few winterizing reminders: Water will be shut off on October 15th, depending on the weather. Updates will be given through our alert system, so be sure to sign up.

While getting your campsite ready for old man winter don't forget to cap your sewer line and your blue tanks.

Fire wood must be stored off the ground per IL Department of Public Health rules.

Question: Can I have a fire in a fire pit after the water is turned off?

Answer: Yes, but it must be kept under control with someone over 18 keeping watch on the fire at all times. A bucket of water close by is highly recommended.



Question: Can I burn leaves?

Answer: Yes, but <u>not</u> after the water goes off. You can also put your leaves in brown paper bags and place them at the road by your camper and we will haul them away.
