Leaves

If you rake leaves and bag them in **BROWN PAPER YARD WASTE BAGS** we will be happy to haul them away. Place them by the side of the road and call the bait shop and let us know they are there. We will be happy to pick them up. We will not pick up plastic bags.

Burning of leaves is not allowed before the water is back on.

IMPORTANT NOTICE **LEASE UPDATE**

There's a new ordinance (2024-01 "Campground Ordinance") regarding name changes on leases.

The Commission will no longer allow any addition of a name on a lease, we will of course allow a removal of a name.

You are limited to two signatures and it would be the two that are on your lease at this time.

Electric News

Our electric supplier has made changes in their fees for having meters turned off and back on. It will actually be cheaper for us to leave the power on now all winter for the campground. This means at the end of the camping season you will still have power at your camper. However, you will not receive an electric bill during the off-season, but you will see whatever usage you may have used over the winter months on your April bill.

This may be a benefit to everyone as it will allow you to keep your camper powered to have the battery charger on the camper. Keeping your batteries up is important. You must have a good battery in your camper for some appliances, slides etc to work properly.

Boat Storage Invoices

If you have a boat storage spot here at the lake, you should have just received an invoice for this fee. Please pay this invoice promptly. It can be paid here in the bait shop or over the phone. Please post your storage sticker on the trailer as soon as you receive it.

Reminder: all permit stickers must be displayed not just purchased

It's that time of year as well to get your new permit stickers for your boat and golf cart. Please get all your permit stickers picked up here at the bait shop and then promptly display them appropriately. I appreciate your cooperation on this, it really helps to make things run smoothly.
